There is hereby re-created, to continue until 14 July 1, 2023 July 1, 2025, pursuant to the provisions of the 15 Oklahoma Sunset Law, the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists. 16 The Board shall administer the provisions of the Psychologists 17 Licensing Act. The Board shall consist of seven (7) members 18 appointed by the Governor. Five members shall be psychologists from 19 various areas in psychology and two members shall be lay persons. 20 At the expiration of the term of each Board member who is a 21 psychologist, the Governor shall appoint a successor from a list of 22 ten licensed psychologists which is provided by the Oklahoma State 23 Psychological Association. Members shall serve for a term of four 24

1	(4) years and until a successor is appointed and qualified. Before
2	entering upon the duties of office, each member of the Board shall
3	take the constitutional oath of office and file it with the
4	Secretary of State.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
