8 An Act relating to the Office of Disability Concerns;  
9 directing the creation of certain regulations for  
10 non-ambulatory parking zones; authorizing Office of  
Disability Concerns to promulgate rules; providing  
for codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9.36 of Title 74, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The Office of Disability Concerns shall create regulations  
18 pertaining to non-ambulatory parking zones for use only by persons  
19 who use mechanical means, which may include but not be limited to a  
20 wheelchair or other mechanical assistance device, to enter or exit a  
21 motor vehicle. Such regulations shall include but not be limited to  
22 color, markings, size, and spacing of the non-ambulatory zones. The  
23 Office of Disability Concerns shall be authorized to promulgate

1 rules and to work with other applicable state agencies to effectuate  
2 the provisions of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
