7 An Act relating to the Attorney General; amending 74  
8 O.S. 2021, Section 20, which relates to publication  
9 of opinions of the Attorney General; requiring  
10 electronic publication of Attorney General opinions;  
11 making written publication of Attorney General  
12 opinions discretionary; updating statutory language;  
13 making language gender neutral; and providing an  
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 20, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 20. A. The Attorney General shall ~~annually~~ publish all  
19 ~~of the~~ written opinions which he or she promulgates in connection  
20 with the interpretation of the laws of ~~the State of Oklahoma~~ this  
21 state in an electronic format that is accessible to the public at no  
22 cost. ~~One copy of the bound volume shall be sent to each state~~  
23 ~~officer, the chairman of each board or commission, and the county~~  
24 ~~law library in each county in the state where the same shall be~~  
~~available to the public and an electronic copy shall be sent to the~~  
~~Publications Clearinghouse of the Oklahoma Department of Libraries.~~

1 ~~A copy of each annual volume is to be placed on file in the~~  
2 ~~Secretary of State's Office and shall be available for public~~  
3 ~~inspection~~ The Attorney General may print the written opinions in  
4 bound volumes at his or her discretion.

5 B. The Attorney General ~~is hereby authorized to~~ may sell any  
6 surplus bound volumes and requested individual copies of opinions to  
7 help cover the cost of the publication, postal charges and other  
8 necessary expenses. ~~and proceeds~~ Proceeds of such sales shall be  
9 deposited into the fund ~~herein~~ established pursuant to subsection C  
10 of this section.

11 C. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
12 fund for the Attorney General, to be designated the Attorney  
13 General's Revolving Fund. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not  
14 subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies  
15 received from the sale of copies of surplus bound volumes and  
16 requested individual copies of opinions and such other monies as are  
17 provided for by law. Expenditures from ~~said~~ the fund shall be made  
18 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as  
19 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and  
20 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.  
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
