14 C. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
15 fund for the Attorney General, to be designated the Attorney
16 General's Revolving Fund. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
17 subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies
18 received from the sale of copies of surplus bound volumes and
19 requested individual copies of opinions and such other monies as are
20 provided for by law. Expenditures from ~~said~~ the fund shall be made
21 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
22 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
23 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
