6 An Act relating to wildlife; authorizing the
7 Department of Wildlife Conservation to produce
8 certain study; requiring distribution of report to
9 the Legislature and Governor; specifying geographic
10 location for study; allowing the Department to use
11 certain sources for data; permitting Department to
12 enter into certain agreements to assist in data
13 collection; allowing for Department to make
14 recommendations; providing for codification; and
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-316 of Title 29, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The Department of Wildlife Conservation shall produce an elk
21 population study to be presented electronically to the Legislature
22 and the Governor on or before a year following the effective date of
23 this act.

24 B. The study shall be used to determine Oklahoma's elk
population in southeastern Oklahoma. The study may incorporate
information available in other sources, such as studies produced by
collegiate or federal resources, into an analysis of Oklahoma's elk

1 population. The Department may also enter into agreements with
2 other agencies, organizations operating in this state, or tribal
3 governments to assist with the production of this study.

4 C. The study may include recommendations by the Department for
5 the conservation of Oklahoma elk populations.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
