NEW LAW 12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 353.20.3 of Title 59, unless 13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 If a pharmacist receives a valid prescription for chloroquine, 15 hydroxychloroquine, or ivermectin, the pharmacist shall not inquire 16 about the intended use of the drug by the patient or the condition 17 for which the drug is prescribed. If the State Board of Pharmacy 18 finds that a pharmacist is in violation of this section, the Board 19 shall immediately revoke the license of the pharmacist and fine the 20 pharmacist One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) per 21 occurrence. 22 SECTION 2.
