7 An Act relating to roadways; defining term; requiring
8 political subdivisions to conduct engineering studies
9 prior to stop sign placement; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 15-117 of Title 47, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. As used in this section, "engineering study" means the
16 evaluation of available pertinent information, and the application
17 of appropriate principles, provisions, and practices by a
18 professional engineer, or by an individual working under the
19 supervision of a professional engineer, for the purpose of deciding
20 upon the applicability, design, operation, or installation of a stop
21 sign.

22 B. Political subdivisions with authority to place signage upon
23 the public roadways within this state, prior to the placement of new
24 stop signs, shall conduct an engineering study to determine whether

1 the chosen stop sign location promotes or hinders the safety of
2 motorists, pedestrians, and others utilizing the roadway affected by
3 the placement of the stop sign.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.

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
