9 An Act relating to special license plates; amending
10 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as last amended by
11 Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
12 2018, Section 1135.2), which relates to special
13 license plates; deleting certain license plate;
14 modifying certain license plates for use on
15 motorcycles; creating the Combat Action Badge
16 Recipient license plate; creating the Iraq Combat
17 Veteran license plate; creating the Afghanistan
18 Combat Veteran license plate; amending 47 O.S. 2011,
19 Section 1135.3, as last amended by Section 24 of
20 Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1041 of the 1st Session of
21 the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to
22 special license plates; demonstrating support;
23 deleting certain license plate; creating plate in
24 support of Toastmasters International; creating plate
in support of the Millwood High School Alumni;
creating plate in support of the Patriot Guard
Riders; creating plate in support of the Bixby School
District; providing for design consultation; amending
47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by
Section 26 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1041 of the
1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, which
relates to specialty plates; allowing Folds of Honor
Supporter license plate for motorcycles;
reauthorizing the Folds of Honor Supporter license
plate; reauthorizing the Sooner State ABATE license
plate; creating the Monarch Butterfly license plate;
creating the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation license
plate; creating Veterans of Foreign Wars license
plate; creating the Oklahoma Women Veterans

1 Organization license plate; creating the FIRST
2 license plate; creating Pittsburg State University
3 license plate; providing for design consultation;
4 updating statutory reference; creating the Monarch
5 Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund and providing
6 for deposit of specified funds thereto; providing for
7 purpose of, and expenditures from, the Monarch
8 Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund; creating
9 Historic Greenwood District/Juneteenth Festival
10 Revolving Fund; providing for codification; and
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
14 last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
15 2018, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
17 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
18 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
19 provided by this section.

20 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
21 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
22 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
23 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
24 registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.

1 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
2 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
3 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
4 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
5 amateur radio operator license plates.

6 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
7 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
8 applications for special license plates authorized under this
9 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
10 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
11 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
12 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
13 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
14 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
15 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
16 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
17 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

18 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
19 follows:

20 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
22 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
23 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
24 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war

1 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
2 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
3 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
4 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
5 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
6 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
7 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
8 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
9 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
10 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

11 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
13 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
14 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
15 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

16 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
18 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
19 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
20 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

21 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
22 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
23 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
24 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or

1 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
2 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
3 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
4 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
5 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or
6 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
7 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
8 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
9 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

10 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
11 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
12 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
13 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
14 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
15 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

16 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
18 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
19 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
20 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
21 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
22 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
23 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
24 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each

1 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
2 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
3 of one (1) ton or less;

4 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
6 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
7 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
8 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
9 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
10 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
11 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
12 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
13 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
14 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
15 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
16 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
17 provided by this section for special license plates;

18 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
20 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
21 the United States as being:

22 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
23 7, 1941,
24

1 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
2 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
3 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
4 exceed three (3) miles, and

5 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
6 States Armed Forces.

7 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
8 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
9 less;

10 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
11 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
12 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
13 States as being:

14 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
15 of 1945,

16 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
17 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and

18 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
19 States Armed Forces.

20 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
21 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

22 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
23 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
24 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the

1 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
2 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
3 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
4 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
5 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
6 registration after the initial issue;

7 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
9 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
10 the United States as being:

- 11 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
12 1944,
- 13 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
14 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
15 participation cannot be verified by the United States
16 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
17 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
18 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
19 the person applying for the license plate, and
- 20 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
21 States Armed Forces.

22 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
23 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

24

1 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
3 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
4 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
5 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
6 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
7 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
8 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
9 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
10 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
11 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
12 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
13 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
14 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

15 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
17 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
18 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
19 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
20 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
21 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
22 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
23 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
24 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to

1 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
2 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

3 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
5 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
6 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
7 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
8 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
9 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
12 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
13 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
14 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
17 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
18 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
19 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
20 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
21 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
22 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
23 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
24 education police department by either an identification card or

1 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
2 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
3 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
4 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
5 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
7 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
8 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
9 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

10 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
12 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
13 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
14 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
15 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
16 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
17 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
18 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

19 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
20 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
21 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
22 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
23 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
24 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate

1 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
2 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
3 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
4 "WORLD WAR II";

5 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
7 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
8 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
9 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
10 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
11 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
12 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
13 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

14 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
15 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
16 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
17 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
18 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
19 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
20 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
21 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
22 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

23 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and

1 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
2 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
3 be produced upon application;

4 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
6 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
7 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
8 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
9 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
10 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
11 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
12 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
13 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
14 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
15 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
16 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
17 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

18 ~~20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall~~
19 ~~be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any~~
20 ~~resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars~~
21 ~~organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of~~
22 ~~Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans~~
23 ~~of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed~~
24 ~~in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;~~

1 ~~21.~~ Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
3 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
4 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
5 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
6 of one (1) ton or less;

7 ~~22.~~ 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates
8 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
9 member of a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such
10 persons may apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each
11 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

12 ~~23.~~ 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License
13 Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or
14 survivor of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
15 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

16 ~~24.~~ 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
18 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
19 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
20 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
21 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

22 ~~25.~~ 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons
24 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in the

1 Ninety-Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
2 with the Ninety-Nines;

3 ~~26.~~ 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman
5 Badge. The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the
6 legend shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers.
7 Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat
8 Infantryman Badge". Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman
9 Badge license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
10 of one (1) ton or less;

11 ~~27.~~ 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
13 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the
14 United Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia
15 Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
16 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

17 ~~28.~~ 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
19 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
20 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
21 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

22 ~~29.~~ 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
24

1 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
2 United States Secretary of Defense;

3 ~~30.~~ 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
5 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
6 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
7 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
8 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
9 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 ~~31.~~ 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall
12 designate the house of the Legislature in which the legislator
13 serves and the district number;

14 ~~32.~~ 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
16 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
17 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
18 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
19 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
20 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
21 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
22 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
23 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
24 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license

1 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
2 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
4 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
5 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
6 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
7 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans
8 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
10 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
11 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
12 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
13 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
14 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

15 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
16 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
17 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
18 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
19 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
20 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
21 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
22 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
23 the Tax Commission;

24

1 ~~33.~~ 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates -
2 such plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air
3 Force Association. Persons applying for such license plate must
4 show proof of membership in the Association. The license plates
5 shall be designed in consultation with the Association;

6 ~~34.~~ 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
8 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
9 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
10 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
11 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
12 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
13 Academy;

14 ~~35.~~ 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid
16 operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the
17 Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a
18 motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
19 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
20 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
21 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
22 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
23 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
24 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call

1 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
2 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
3 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
4 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
5 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
6 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
7 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
8 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
9 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
10 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
11 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
12 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
13 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
14 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
15 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

16 ~~36.~~ 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
18 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
19 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
20 Oklahoma;

21 ~~37.~~ 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
23 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
24 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or

1 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
2 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the

19 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
20 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

21 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
22 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
23 applications for special license plates authorized under this
24 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's

1 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
2 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
3 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
4 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
5 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
6 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
7 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

9 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
10 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
11 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
12 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
13 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
14 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
15 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
16 removed from the vehicle.

17 Except as otherwise provided in law, for special license plates
18 authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall

20 receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. The
21 prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within

23 authorization or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In
24 the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by

1 the Tax Commission within such prescribed time period any payment so
2 received shall be refunded accordingly.

9 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

12 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
13 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
14 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
15 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
16 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
17 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
18 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
19 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

20 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
21 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
22 applications for special license plates authorized under this
23 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
24 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount

1 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
2 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
3 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
4 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
5 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
6 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

8 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
9 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
10 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
11 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
12 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
13 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
14 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
15 removed from the vehicle.

16 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
17 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
18 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
19 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
20 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
21 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
22 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
23 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
24 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

22 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
23 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

1 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
3 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
4 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
5 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
6 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
7 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
8 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
9 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
10 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
11 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
13 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
14 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
15 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
16 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
19 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
20 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

21 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
23 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
24 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any

1 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
2 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
3 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
4 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
5 plates.

6 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
7 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
8 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

11 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State

14 the prevention of child abuse.

23 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if

3 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
4 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate

15 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical

6 Section 1104.4 of this title;

7 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
9 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
12 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
13 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
14 1104.3 of this title;

15 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
17 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
18 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
19 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
21 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
22 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
23 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
4 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
6 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
7 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
8 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
9 follows:

- 10 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
11 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 12 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
13 Education Revolving Fund,
- 14 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State

1 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
3 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
4 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
5 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
6 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
7 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
8 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
9 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
10 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of

2 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
3 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
4 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
5 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
6 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
8 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
9 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
10 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
11 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
12 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
14 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
15 of this title;

16 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
18 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
19 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
20 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
22 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
23 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

2 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
3 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and

7 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
8 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.

11 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of

5 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
6 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
7 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
8 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
9 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
10 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
11 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
12 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
13 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
14 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
15 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
16 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

17 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
19 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
20 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
21 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
22 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
23 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
24 Section 1104.8 of this title;

1 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
2 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
3 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
4 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
5 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
6 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
7 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
8 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
9 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
10 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
11 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
12 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
13 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
14 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
15 plate issued;

16 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
18 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be
19 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.
20 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
21 agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing
22 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City
23 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
24

1 provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not

16 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
18 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
19 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
21 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
22 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
23 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
24

1 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
2 Section 1104.10 of this title;

3 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to

12 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be

17 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
18 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As

22 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -

3 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls

10 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
11 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
12 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
13 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
14 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
15 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
16 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
17 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

18 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
20 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
21 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
22 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
23 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
24 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax

1 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
2 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
3 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
4 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
5 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
6 each license plate issued;

7 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
8 be authorized to be designed and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Chapter of Folds of Honor
10 Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization exempt from
11 taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26
12 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing educational scholarships to
13 spouses and children of America's fallen and disabled military
14 service members. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
15 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.
16 Such person may apply for a Folds of Honor Supporter license plate
17 for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be
18 of similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be

9 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
10 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
11 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
12 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
13 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
14 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
15 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
16 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
17 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
18 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in

13 Police Survivors, Inc. As provided in this section, an amount of
14 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Concerns of
15 Police Survivors License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section
16 1104.27 of this title;

17 61. Disabled American Veterans License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed in consultation with the Disabled American
19 Veterans Department of Oklahoma and issued to any member of the
20 organization wishing to demonstrate support. The Tax Commission
21 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the
22 Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma for any licensing
23 fees which may be required in order to use the organization's logo
24 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to

1 the Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma of not more
2 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued. The
3 plates shall incorporate a numbering system agreed upon by the
4 Disabled American Veterans Department of Oklahoma and the Tax
5 Commission;

6 62. Owasso Rams Supporter License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Owasso Rams, and shall be designed in consultation with
9 representatives of Owasso Schools. The plates shall be issued to
10 any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
11 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided
12 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
13 in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of
14 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 63. Collinsville Cardinals Supporter License Plate - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
17 demonstrate support for the Collinsville Cardinals, and shall be
18 designed in consultation with representatives of Collinsville
19 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
20 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
21 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
22 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education
23 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
24 Oklahoma Statutes;

1 64. Sperry Pirates Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for the Sperry Pirates, and shall be designed in consultation with
4 representatives of Sperry Schools. The plates shall be issued to
5 any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
6 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided
7 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
8 in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of
9 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 65. Skiatook Bulldogs Supporter License Plate - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
12 support for the Skiatook Bulldogs, and shall be designed in
13 consultation with representatives of Skiatook Schools. The plates
14 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
15 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license
16 plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
17 shall be deposited in the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in
18 Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 66. Rejoice Christian Eagles Supporter License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
21 demonstrate support for the Rejoice Christian Eagles, and shall be
22 designed in consultation with representatives of Rejoice Christian
23 Schools. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
24 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,

1 as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an
2 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Education
3 Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the
4 Oklahoma Statutes;

5 67. East Central Cardinals Supporter License Plate - such
6 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

2 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for Sooner
3 State ABATE. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
4 with Sooner State ABATE. The plates shall be issued to any person
5 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
6 seven, as for personalized plates. The license plate for a
7 motorcycle may be of similar design as space permits or a new design
8 in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license
9 plate. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
10 licensing agreement with Sooner State ABATE for any licensing fees,
11 which may be required in order to use the association's logo or
12 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
13 Sooner State ABATE of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
14 license plate issued. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of
15 this section, the Sooner State ABATE License Plate is hereby
16 reauthorized effective November 1, 2019;

17 70. Oklahoma License to Educate License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support for Oklahoma educators. Such plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with the State Department of Education. As provided in
21 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in
22 the Oklahoma Teacher Recruitment Revolving Fund created in Section
23 6-132 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 71. Piedmont Education Foundation License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the Piedmont Public Schools Education Foundation. Such
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Foundation. As
5 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
6 deposited in the Piedmont Public Schools Education Foundation
7 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.28 of this
8 title;

9 72. The Pride of Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
11 the University of Oklahoma Marching Band and shall be designed in
12 consultation with the University of Oklahoma Marching Band. The
13 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
14 licensing agreement with the University of Oklahoma or the
15 University of Oklahoma Marching Band for any licensing fees which
16 may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design. The
17 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Pride of
18 Oklahoma Fund at the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Inc. of not
19 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

20 73. Jenks Trojans License Plate - such plates shall be designed
21 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
22 Jenks School District. The license plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with the administration of the Jenks School District.
24 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing

1 agreement with the Jenks School District for any licensing fees
2 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
3 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
4 Jenks School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
5 each license plate issued;

6 74. Bixby Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Bixby School District. The license plates shall be designed in
9 consultation with the administration of the Bixby School District.
10 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
11 agreement with the Bixby School District for any licensing fees
12 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
14 Bixby School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
15 each license plate issued;

16 75. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
18 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness
19 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
21 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
22 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four
23 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
24

1 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
2 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 76. Ducks Unlimited License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 Ducks Unlimited. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with
6 Ducks Unlimited. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
7 enter into a licensing agreement with Ducks Unlimited for any
8 licensing fee which may be required in order to use the Ducks
9 Unlimited logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
10 a payment to Ducks Unlimited of not more than Twenty Dollars
11 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

12 77. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate - such
13 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
14 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and
15 provide financial support for current veterans. The license plates
16 shall be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. As
17 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
18 deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
19 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.29 of this title;

20 78. Woodward Boomers License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
22 the Woodward School District. The license plates shall be designed
23 in consultation with the administration of the Woodward School
24 District. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a

1 licensing agreement with the Woodward School District for any
2 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school
3 district's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
4 for a payment to the Woodward School District of not more than
5 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

6 79. Clinton Public School Foundation License Plate - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for the Clinton Public School Foundation. The
9 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Clinton
10 Public School Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
11 enter into a licensing agreement with the Clinton Public School
12 Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
13 use the school foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement
14 shall provide for a payment to the Clinton Public School Foundation
15 of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate
16 issued;

17 80. Navajo School Foundation License Plate - such plates shall
18 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
19 Navajo School Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with the administration of the Navajo School
21 Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
22 enter into a licensing agreement with the Navajo School Foundation
23 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
24 Foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide

1 for a payment to the Navajo School Foundation of not more than
2 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

3 81. Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Inc. License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Music
5 Hall of Fame Inc. and issued to any member of the organization
6 wishing to demonstrate support. The Tax Commission shall be
7 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma
8 Music Hall of Fame Inc. for any licensing fees which may be required
9 in order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
10 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Music Hall of
11 Fame Inc. of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
12 plate issued. The plates shall incorporate a numbering system
13 agreed upon by the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Inc. and the Tax
14 Commission;

15 82. Techlahoma Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
16 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
17 Techlahoma Foundation. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Techlahoma Foundation. The plate shall be
19 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
20 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. The Tax
21 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
22 with the Techlahoma Foundation for any licensing fees, which may be
23 required in order to use the association's logo or design. The
24 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Techlahoma

1 Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
2 plate issued;

3 83. Bethany Public Schools Foundation License Plate - such
4 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
5 for the Bethany Public Schools Foundation. The license plates shall
6 be designed in consultation with the administration of the Bethany
7 Public Schools Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
8 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Bethany
9 Public Schools Foundation for any licensing fees which may be
10 required in order to use the Foundation's logo or design. The
11 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Bethany
12 Public Schools Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)
13 for each license plate issued;

14 84. Cystic Fibrosis Foundation License Plate - such plates
15 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
16 Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
17 consultation with the administration of the Cystic Fibrosis
18 Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
19 enter into a licensing agreement with the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation
20 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
21 Foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
22 for a payment to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation of not more than
23 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

1 85. Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma License Plate
2 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Down Syndrome Association of Central
4 Oklahoma. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with the
5 Association. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
6 collected shall be deposited in the Down Syndrome Association of
7 Central Oklahoma License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section
8 1104.30 of this title;

9 86. Elk City Education Foundation License Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
11 support for the Elk City Education Foundation. Such plates shall be
12 designed in consultation with the Foundation. As provided in this
13 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
14 Elk City Education Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund created
15 in Section 1104.31 of this title;

16 87. A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma (ABATE)
17 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
18 person wishing to provide financial support for ABATE of Oklahoma.
19 Such plates shall be designed in consultation with ABATE of
20 Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
22 as for personalized plates. The license plate for a motorcycle may
23 be of similar design as space permits or a new design in order to
24 meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The

1 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
2 licensing agreement with ABATE of Oklahoma for any licensing fees
3 which may be required in order to use the ABATE of Oklahoma logo or
4 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
5 ABATE of Oklahoma of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
6 license plate issued;

7 88. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
8 be designed for a vehicle or motorcycle in any combination of
9 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
10 personalized plates, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
11 support for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
12 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
13 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
14 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
15 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
16 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
17 official logo or design of the organization. The license plate for
18 a motorcycle may be of similar design as space permits or a new
19 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
20 license plate. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a
21 licensing agreement with the Downed Bikers Association for any
22 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
23 organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall

24

1 provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers Association of not more
2 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate;

3 89. Eagle Scout License Plate - Such plates shall be designed
4 to demonstrate support for Eagle Scouts and shall include the Eagle
5 Scout logo. Plates may be issued to any person who can show proof
6 of having obtained the rank of Eagle Scout. The Oklahoma Tax
7 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
8 with the various Oklahoma local councils for any licensing fees
9 which may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design.
10 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than
11 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued to the
12 specific Oklahoma local area Council designated by the applicant;

13 90. Extraordinary Educators License Plate - such plates shall
14 be designed and issued to any person wishing to provide financial
15 support for common education in Oklahoma. Such plates shall be
16 designed in consultation with the State Department of Education.
17 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
18 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
19 personalized plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the
20 fee collected shall be deposited in the Extraordinary Educators
21 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.32 of this
22 title; and

23 91. Former Oklahoma Legislator License Plate - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person who previously served as

1 a member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives or Oklahoma State
2 Senate. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
3 the Oklahoma Historical Society. As provided in this section, an
4 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
5 Historical Society Capital Improvement and Operations Revolving Fund
6 created in Section 1.10a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The
7 Tax Commission shall create and maintain a list of former members of
8 the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
9 eligible to be issued such plates; provided, that no former member
10 of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
11 shall be eligible to possess more than two of such plates at any one
12 time. The Tax Commission shall confer as needed with the Chief
13 Clerk of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Secretary of
14 the Oklahoma State Senate to confirm that such list is complete and
15 accurate;

16 92. Monarch Butterfly License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
18 the operations of the Nature Conservancy in Oklahoma. Such plates
19 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
20 Nature Conservancy. As provided in this section, an amount of the
21 fee collected shall be deposited in the Monarch Butterfly License
22 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 4 of this act;

23 93. Oklahoma Tennis Foundation License Plate - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

1 support for the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation. The license plates
2 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Tennis
3 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
4 licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation for any
5 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
6 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
7 for a payment to the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation of not more than
8 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

9 94. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
11 for the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation. The license plates
12 shall be designed in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars
13 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
14 licensing agreement with the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation for
15 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
16 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
17 for a payment to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation of not more
18 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

19 95. Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any female veteran of any
21 branch of the United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate
22 support for the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization. The license
23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Women
24 Veterans Organization. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to

1 enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Women Veterans
2 Organization for any licensing fees which may be required in order
3 to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement
4 shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Women Veterans
5 Organization of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
6 license plate issued;

7 96. FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and
8 Technology) License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any
9 person wishing to demonstrate support for FIRST Robotics Programs.
10 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
11 administration of FIRST. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
12 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with FIRST for any
13 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the FIRST logo
14 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
15 FIRST of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
16 plate issued;

17 97. Pittsburg State University License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support for the Pittsburg State University. The license plates
20 shall be designed in consultation with Pittsburg State University.
21 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
22 agreement with Pittsburg State University for any licensing fees
23 which may be required in order to use the school foundation's logo
24 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to

1 the Pittsburg State University of not more than Twenty Dollars
2 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

3 98. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
4 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the
5 Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth Festival held in the Historic
6 Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued
7 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
8 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
9 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Black Wall Street
10 Chamber of Commerce. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee
11 collected shall be deposited in the Historic Greenwood
12 District/Juneteenth Festival Revolving Fund established in Section 5
13 of this act. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the fee collected shall be
14 deposited in the Public School Classroom Support Revolving Fund, for
15 expenditure as provided in Section 1-123 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
16 Statutes.

17 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
18 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
19 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
20 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

21 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
22 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as
23 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph
24 authorizing the special license plate;

1 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
2 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
3 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
4 Registration Act; and

5 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
6 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

7 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.33 of Title 47, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
11 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Monarch Butterfly
12 license plates shall be deposited to the Monarch Butterfly License
13 Plate Revolving Fund created in subsection B of this section.

14 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
15 fund for the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to be designated the
16 "Monarch Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund shall
17 consist of all monies received pursuant to subsection A of this
18 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
19 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
20 Conservation Commission for grants to the Oklahoma Chapter of the
21 Nature Conservancy to fund the Conservancy's operations in this
22 state. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
23 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
24

1 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
2 Services for approval and payment.

3 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2368.32 of Title 68, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
7 to be designated the "Historic Greenwood District/Juneteenth
8 Festival Revolving Fund" and administered by the Oklahoma Department
9 of Commerce. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to
10 fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all the monies
11 received by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce pursuant to the
12 provisions related to the Historic Greenwood District License Plate
13 in Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All monies
14 accruing to the credit of the fund are appropriated and may be
15 budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce at the
16 beginning of each fiscal year for the purpose of providing grants to
17 support and promote the Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth
18 Festival in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
19 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
20 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
21 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
22 approval and payment and in consultation with the Black Wall Street
23 Chamber of Commerce.
