13                   47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as last amended by  
14                   Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.  
15                   2018, Section 1135.2), which relates to special  
16                   license plates; deleting certain license plate;  
17                   modifying certain license plates for use on  
18                   motorcycles; creating the Combat Action Badge  
19                   Recipient license plate; creating the Iraq Combat  
20                   Veteran license plate; creating the Afghanistan  
21                   Combat Veteran license plate; amending 47 O.S. 2011,  
22                   Section 1135.3, as last amended by Section 24 of  
23                   Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1041 of the 1st Session of  
24                   the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to  
                 special license plates; demonstrating support;  
                 deleting certain license plate; creating plate in  
                 support of Toastmasters International; creating plate  
                 in support of the Millwood High School Alumni;  
                 creating plate in support of the Patriot Guard  
                 Riders; creating plate in support of the Bixby School  
                 District; providing for design consultation; amending  
                 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by  
                 Section 26 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1041 of the  
                 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, which  
                 relates to specialty plates; allowing Folds of Honor  
                 Supporter license plate for motorcycles;

1 reauthorizing the Folds of Honor Supporter license  
2 plate; reauthorizing the Sooner State ABATE license  
3 plate; creating the Monarch Butterfly license plate;  
4 creating the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation license  
5 plate; creating Veterans of Foreign Wars license  
6 plate; creating the Oklahoma Women Veterans  
7 Organization license plate; creating the FIRST  
8 license plate; creating Pittsburg State University  
9 license plate; creating Historic Greenwood District  
10 license plate; providing for design consultation;  
11 updating statutory reference; creating the Monarch  
12 Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund and providing  
13 for deposit of specified funds thereto; providing for  
14 purpose of, and expenditures from, the Monarch  
15 Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund; creating  
16 Historic Greenwood District/Juneteenth Festival  
17 Revolving Fund; providing for codification; and  
18 providing an effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as  
21 last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.  
22 2018, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

23 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
24 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as  
provided by this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
2 registered for the current year.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
4 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
6 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
7 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
8 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
9 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and  
10 amateur radio operator license plates.

11 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
12 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
13 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
14 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
15 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
16 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
17 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
18 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
19 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
20 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
21 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
22 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

23 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
24 follows:

1           1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United  
3 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war  
4 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification  
5 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war  
6 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having  
7 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving  
8 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not  
9 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by  
10 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war  
11 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one  
12 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
13 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
14 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
15 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

16           2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National  
18 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide  
19 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be  
20 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

21           3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National  
23 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide  
24

1 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be  
2 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed  
4 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States  
5 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry  
6 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or  
7 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member  
8 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably  
9 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying  
10 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military  
11 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or  
12 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or  
13 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof  
14 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required  
15 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

16 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such  
17 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been  
18 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply  
19 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each  
20 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.  
21 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

22 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be  
23 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are  
24 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse

1 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is  
2 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the  
3 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon  
4 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action  
5 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse  
6 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each  
7 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in  
8 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
9 of one (1) ton or less;

10 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper  
12 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs  
13 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such  
14 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.  
15 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate  
16 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
17 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been  
18 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not  
19 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated  
20 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one  
21 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The  
22 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee  
23 provided by this section for special license plates;

24

1 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the  
3 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
4 the United States as being:

5 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December  
6 7, 1941,

7 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of  
8 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,  
9 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to  
10 exceed three (3) miles, and

11 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
12 States Armed Forces.

13 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate  
14 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
15 less;

16 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for  
17 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States  
18 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United  
19 States as being:

20 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February  
21 of 1945,

22 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate  
23 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and  
24

1 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
2 States Armed Forces.

3 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each  
4 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

5 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall  
6 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and  
7 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the  
8 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."  
9 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such  
10 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other  
11 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the  
12 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of  
13 registration after the initial issue;

14 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be  
15 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the  
16 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
17 the United States as being:

18 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,  
19 1944,

20 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of  
21 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such  
22 participation cannot be verified by the United States  
23 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
24 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its

1 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from  
2 the person applying for the license plate, and

3 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
4 States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for  
6 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

7 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be  
8 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were  
9 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse  
10 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by  
11 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action  
12 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person  
13 was killed in action and that the person making the application is  
14 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse  
15 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two  
16 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)  
17 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
18 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
19 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
20 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

21 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were  
23 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply  
24 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification

1 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making  
2 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent  
3 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two  
4 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one  
5 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
6 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
7 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
8 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

9 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be  
10 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the  
11 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the  
12 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or  
13 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a  
14 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
15 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

16 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United  
18 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such  
19 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each  
20 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

21 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal  
23 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police  
24 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and

1 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council  
2 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may  
3 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated  
4 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of  
5 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common  
6 education police department by either an identification card or  
7 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma  
8 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for  
9 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial  
10 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of  
11 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in  
12 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;  
13 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design  
14 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in  
15 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

16 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United  
18 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be  
19 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of  
20 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having  
21 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from  
22 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may  
23 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a  
24 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

1 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall  
2 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia  
3 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold  
4 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,  
5 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which  
6 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate  
7 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at  
8 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.  
9 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words  
10 "WORLD WAR II";

11 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
12 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United  
13 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be  
14 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of  
15 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having  
16 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June  
17 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former  
18 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for  
19 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

20 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall  
21 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia  
22 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold  
23 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or  
24 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member

1 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the  
2 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two  
3 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the  
4 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

5 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be  
6 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and  
7 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or  
8 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only  
9 be produced upon application;

10 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are  
12 residents of this state. Such persons must present an  
13 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a  
14 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with  
15 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend  
16 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the  
17 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and  
18 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the  
19 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red  
20 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design  
21 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other  
22 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each  
23 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

1       ~~20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall~~  
2 ~~be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any~~  
3 ~~resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars~~  
4 ~~organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of~~  
5 ~~Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans~~  
6 ~~of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed~~  
7 ~~in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;~~

8       ~~21.~~ Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
9 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the  
10 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and  
11 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert  
12 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
13 of one (1) ton or less;

14       ~~22.~~ 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates  
15 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present  
16 member of a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such  
17 persons may apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each  
18 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19       ~~23.~~ 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License  
20 Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or  
21 survivor of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal  
22 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

23       ~~24.~~ 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be  
24 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air

1 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate  
2 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
3 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license  
4 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

5 ~~25.~~ 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be  
6 designed and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons  
7 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in the  
8 Ninety-Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation  
9 with the Ninety-Nines;

10 ~~26.~~ 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates  
11 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman  
12 Badge. The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the  
13 legend shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers.  
14 Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat  
15 Infantryman Badge". Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman  
16 Badge license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
17 of one (1) ton or less;

18 ~~27.~~ 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates  
19 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present  
20 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the  
21 United Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia  
22 Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

24

1       ~~28.~~ 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of  
3 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for  
4 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall  
5 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

6       ~~29.~~ 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such  
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state  
8 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the  
9 United States Secretary of Defense;

10       ~~30.~~ 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
12 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any  
13 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as  
14 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such  
15 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
16 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

17       ~~31.~~ 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be  
18 designed for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall  
19 designate the house of the Legislature in which the legislator  
20 serves and the district number;

21       ~~32.~~ 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be  
22 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United  
23 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the  
24 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected

1 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which  
2 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been  
3 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a  
4 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the  
5 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability  
6 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons  
7 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license  
8 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no  
9 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying  
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any  
11 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or  
12 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or  
13 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and  
14 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans  
15 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one  
16 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The  
17 fee provided by this section for the special license plate  
18 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other  
19 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees  
20 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this  
21 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

22 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate  
23 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the  
24 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be

1 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also  
2 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized  
3 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled  
4 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the  
5 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to  
6 the Tax Commission;

7 ~~33.~~ 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates -  
8 such plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air  
9 Force Association. Persons applying for such license plate must  
10 show proof of membership in the Association. The license plates  
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Association;

12 ~~34.~~ 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such  
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state  
14 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons  
15 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for  
16 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.  
17 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the  
18 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the  
19 Academy;

20 ~~35.~~ 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates  
21 shall be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid  
22 operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the  
23 Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a  
24 motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been

1 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.  
2 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle  
3 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such  
4 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax  
5 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have  
6 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call  
7 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications  
8 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All  
9 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on  
10 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for

1 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special  
2 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information  
3 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon  
4 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The  
5 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

6 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
7 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
8 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
9 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
10 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
11 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
12 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
13 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
14 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
15 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
16 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
17 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

18 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
19 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
20 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
21 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special

12 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.  
13 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four  
14 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a  
15 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an  
16 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.  
17 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any  
20 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may  
21 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated

2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
3 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The  
4 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
5 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of  
6 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -  
7 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to  
8 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

9 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,  
10 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the  
11 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
12 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued  
13 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in  
14 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to  
15 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in  
16 Section 1104.4 of this title;

17 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be  
18 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,  
19 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in  
20 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any  
21 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the  
22 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount  
23 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section  
24 1104.3 of this title;

1           16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates  
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate  
3 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The  
4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
5 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As  
6 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be  
7 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial  
8 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of  
9 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10           17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be  
11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
12 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the  
13 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to  
14 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license  
15 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate  
16 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three  
17 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as  
18 follows:

- 19           a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education  
20           Reform Revolving Fund,
- 21           b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher  
22           Education Revolving Fund,
- 23           c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State

5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
6 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued  
7 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to  
8 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate  
9 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax  
10 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a  
11 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing  
12 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America  
13 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment  
14 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars  
15 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

16 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such  
17 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
18 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and  
19 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state  
20 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and  
21 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
22 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of  
23 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5  
24 of this title;

1           21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates  
2 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax  
3 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and  
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma  
5 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee  
6 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation  
7 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and  
8 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

9           22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall  
10 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant  
11 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and  
12 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and  
13 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of  
14 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be  
15 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the  
16 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.  
17 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited  
18 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be  
19 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of  
20 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for  
21 created families;

22           23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,  
23 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,  
24 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of

1 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women  
2 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount  
3 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life  
4 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of  
5 this title;

6 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall  
7 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for  
8 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The  
9 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
10 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an  
11 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
12 Section 1104.7 of this title;

13 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
14 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions  
15 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any  
16 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,  
17 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be  
18 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation  
19 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association  
20 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter  
21 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service  
22 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to  
23 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars  
24 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

1           26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be  
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
3 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person  
4 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting  
5 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's  
6 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,  
7 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in  
8 Section 1104.8 of this title;

9           27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter  
10 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any  
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the  
12 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person  
13 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of  
14 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain  
15 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The  
16 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a  
17 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of  
18 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use  
19 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The  
20 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts  
21 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout  
22 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license  
23 plate issued;

1       28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates  
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
3 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be  
4 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.  
5 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing  
6 agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing  
7 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City  
8 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall  
9 provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not  
10 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

17 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.  
18 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The  
19 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the  
20 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be  
21 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty  
22 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma  
23 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

1        31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be  
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
3 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational  
4 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in  
5 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty  
6 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the  
7 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet  
8 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the  
9 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in  
10 Section 1104.10 of this title;

11        32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in  
12 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to  
13 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who  
14 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active  
15 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination  
16 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for  
17 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion  
18 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate  
19 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

20        33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be  
21 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma  
22 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma  
23 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States  
24 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on

1 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any  
2 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As  
3 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be  
4 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in  
5 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -  
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
8 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The  
9 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers  
10 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized  
11 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls  
12 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter  
13 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America  
14 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the  
15 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing  
16 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of  
17 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license  
18 plate issued;

19 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plate - such plates shall be  
20 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
21 the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be designed  
22 in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Association. As  
23 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be  
24

1 deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving Fund created in  
2 Section 1104.12 of this title;

3 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such  
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma  
5 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to  
6 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates  
7 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and  
8 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license  
9 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected  
10 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License  
11 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

12 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be  
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma  
14 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
15 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,  
16 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma  
17 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this  
18 title;

19 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued  
20 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes  
21 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,  
22 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be  
23 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.  
24 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be

1 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and  
2 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

3 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates  
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
5 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be  
6 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from  
7 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official  
8 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark  
9 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax  
10 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with  
11 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be  
12 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or  
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to  
14 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for  
15 each license plate issued;

16 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall  
17 be authorized to be designed and issued to any person wishing to  
18 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Chapter of Folds of Honor  
19 Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization exempt from  
20 taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26  
21 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing educational scholarships to  
22 spouses and children of America's fallen and disabled military  
23 service members. The plates shall be issued to any person in any  
24 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.

1 Such person may apply for a Folds of Honor Supporter license plate

20 94. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate - such plates shall  
21 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support  
22 for the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation. The license plates  
23 shall be designed in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars  
24 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a

1 licensing agreement with the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation for  
2 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the  
3 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide  
4 for a payment to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation of not more  
5 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

6 95. Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization License Plate - such  
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any female veteran of any  
8 branch of the United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate  
9 support for the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization. The license  
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Women  
11 Veterans Organization. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to  
12 enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Women Veterans  
13 Organization for any licensing fees which may be required in order  
14 to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement  
15 shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Women Veterans  
16 Organization of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each  
17 license plate issued;

18 96. FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and  
19 Technology) License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any  
20 person wishing to demonstrate support for FIRST Robotics Programs.  
21 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the  
22 administration of FIRST. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be  
23 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with FIRST for any  
24 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the FIRST logo

1 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to  
2 FIRST of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license  
3 plate issued;

4 97. Pittsburg State University License Plate - such plates  
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
6 support for the Pittsburg State University. The license plates  
7 shall be designed in consultation with Pittsburg State University.  
8 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing  
9 agreement with Pittsburg State University for any licensing fees  
10 which may be required in order to use the school foundation's logo  
11 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to  
12 the Pittsburg State University of not more than Twenty Dollars  
13 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

14 98. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates  
15 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the  
16 Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth Festival held in the Historic  
17 Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued  
18 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to  
19 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license  
20 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Black Wall Street  
21 Chamber of Commerce. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee  
22 collected shall be deposited in the Historic Greenwood  
23 District/Juneteenth Festival Revolving Fund established in Section 5  
24 of this act. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the fee collected shall be

1 deposited in the Public School Classroom Support Revolving Fund, for  
2 expenditure as provided in Section 1-123 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma  
3 Statutes.

4 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars  
5 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other  
6 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
7 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

8 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other  
9 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as  
10 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph  
11 authorizing the special license plate;

12 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall  
13 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be  
14 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
15 Registration Act; and

16 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as  
17 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

18 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.33 of Title 47, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section  
22 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for Monarch Butterfly  
23 license plates shall be deposited to the Monarch Butterfly License  
24 Plate Revolving Fund created in subsection B of this section.

1 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
2 fund for the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to be designated the  
3 "Monarch Butterfly License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund shall  
4 consist of all monies received pursuant to subsection A of this  
5 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
6 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma  
7 Conservation Commission for grants to the Oklahoma Chapter of the  
8 Nature Conservancy to fund the Conservancy's operations in this  
9 state. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants  
10 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
11 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
12 Services for approval and payment.

13 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2368.32 of Title 68, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
17 to be designated the "Historic Greenwood District/Juneteenth  
18 Festival Revolving Fund" and administered by the Oklahoma Department  
19 of Commerce. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to  
20 fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all the monies  
21 received by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce pursuant to the  
22 provisions related to the Historic Greenwood District License Plate  
23 in Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All monies  
24 accruing to the credit of the fund are appropriated and may be

1 budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce at the  
2 beginning of each fiscal year for the purpose of providing grants to  
3 support and promote the Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth  
4 Festival in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma.  
5 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the  
6 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the  
7 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for  
8 approval and payment and in consultation with the Black Wall Street  
9 Chamber of Commerce.

10 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
