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6	An Act relating to schools; creating a task force to study school administrative costs and identify
7	efficiencies; providing expiration date; setting duties; providing for membership; providing for

9	Oklahoma Open Meeting Act; providing that members receive no compensation or travel reimbursement;
10	providing for staff support; requiring certain report; providing for noncodification; providing an
11	effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
17	A. There is hereby created until December 31, 2015, a task
18	force to study school administrative costs, identify efficiencies
19	and develop recommendations for producing savings to be directed
20	toward the classroom.
21	B. The task force shall be comprised of thirteen (13) members
22	to be appointed as follows:
23	1. Three members appointed by the Governor;
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2. Three members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
 2 Senate;

3 3. Three members appointed by the Speaker of the House of4 Representatives;

4. Two members who are employees of a school district with an
average daily membership of one thousand (1,000) or more, appointed
by the State Board of Education from a list of recommendations
submitted by a statewide organization that represents public school
superintendents; and

10 5. Two members who are employees of a school district with an 11 average daily membership of less than one thousand (1,000), 12 appointed by the State Board of Education from a list of 13 recommendations submitted by a statewide organization that 14 represents public school superintendents.

The chair of the task force shall be selected by the Governor.
C. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any
final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, seven
(7) members shall constitute a quorum.

D. The task force may meet as often as may be required in orderto perform the duties imposed upon it.

E. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to theOklahoma Open Meeting Act.

F. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation ortravel reimbursement.

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1	G. Staff support shall be provided by the State Department of
2	Education, the Senate and the House of Representatives.
3	H. The task force shall submit a report of its findings and
4	recommendations by November 30, 2015, to the Governor, the President
5	Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
6	Representatives.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
8	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
