12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1381 of Title 22, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	Notwithstanding any other provision of law concerning
17	postconviction relief, a district attorney in the jurisdiction in
18	which a person was convicted of an offense may file a motion in the
19	district court to vacate or set aside a judgment of conviction at
20	any time if clear and convincing evidence exists establishing that
21	the defendant was convicted of an offense that the defendant did not
22	commit. The district court shall have jurisdiction and authority to
23	consider, hear, and decide the motion.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
