6 An Act relating to security guards and private  
7 investigators; amending 59 O.S. 2021, Section  
8 1750.10A, which relates to armed security guard  
9 firearm training; authorizing security guards to  
10 carry rifles during the performance of their duties;  
11 and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1750.10A, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1750.10A. A. An armed security guard shall be  
16 authorized to carry a rifle during the performance of his or her  
17 duties.

18 B. The firearm training for armed security guards may include  
19 the reduction targets for weapons fired at fifty (50) feet to  
20 simulate weapons fired at seventy-five (75) feet in indoor ranges.  
21 All indoor ranges for this training shall have a minimum of three  
22 firing lanes and be approved by the Council on Law Enforcement  
23 Education and Training.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
