10                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11                   An Act relating to security guards and private  
12                   investigators; amending 59 O.S. 2021, Section  
13                   1750.10A, which relates to armed security guard  
14                   firearm training; authorizing security guards to  
15                   carry long guns and handguns during the performance  
16                   of their duties; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17                   SECTION 1.            AMENDATORY            59 O.S. 2021, Section 1750.10A, is  
18                   amended to read as follows:

19                   Section 1750.10A A. An armed security guard shall be  
20                   authorized to carry any long gun or handgun during the performance  
21                   of his or her duties; provided, the armed security guard has met  
22                   CLEET qualifications.

23                   B. The firearm training for armed security guards may include  
24                   the reduction targets for weapons fired at fifty (50) feet to

1 simulate weapons fired at seventy-five (75) feet in indoor ranges.  
2 All indoor ranges for this training shall have a minimum of three  
3 firing lanes and be approved by the Council on Law Enforcement  
4 Education and Training.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
