The income limit shall be one hundred seventy percent (170%) of the federal poverty level (FPL) guidelines and there shall be no asset limit for SNAP BBCE under this section. C. The Department shall seek any federal approval and fulfill any federal requirements necessary to implement the provisions of this section. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025. SECTION 3.
