SENATE BILL 1856

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to carbon sequestration; directing office of the Secretary of Energy and Environment to create and administer grant program for certain entities; requiring grant program be subject to Legislative appropriation; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-6-101 of Title 27A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The office of the Secretary of Energy and Environment shall create and administer a grant program for entities utilizing sequestration of carbon captured from production of hydrogen from natural gas. The Secretary shall determine criteria for the program and establish a process for consideration of proposals. The grant program shall be subject to appropriations from the Legislature.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
