10	to carry; prohibiting certain carry for persons serving probation; removing certain revocation;
11	modifying definitions; and providing an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1283, as
16	last amended by Section 3, Chapter 1, O.S.L. 2019 (21 O.S. Supp.
17	2020, Section 1283), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 1283.
19	CONVICTED FELONS AND DELINQUENTS
20	A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, it shall
21	be unlawful for any person convicted of any felony in any court of
22	this state or of another state or of the United States to have in
23	his or her possession or under his or her immediate control, or in
24 2 7	any vehicle which the person is operating, or in which the person is

¹ riding as a passenger, or at the residence where the convicted ² person resides, any pistol, imitation or homemade pistol, altered ³ air or toy pistol, machine gun, sawed-off shotgun or <u>sawed-off</u> ⁴ rifle, or any other <u>dangerous or deadly</u> firearm.

5 Any person who has previously been convicted of a nonviolent в. 6 felony in any court of this state or of another state or of the 7 United States, and who has received a full and complete pardon from 8 the proper authority and has not been convicted of any other 9 misdemeanor or felony offense which has not been pardoned for a 10 period of five (5) years since the completion of the sentence for 11 the last misdemeanor or felony offense and no felony and misdemeanor 12 charges are pending against the person, shall have restored the 13 right to possess, carry or transport any non-semi-automatic firearm 14 or other weapon prohibited by subsection A of this section, the 15 right to The non-violent felon may apply for and carry a handgun, 16 concealed or unconcealed, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma 17 Self-Defense Act or as otherwise permitted by law, and have the 18 right to perform the duties of a peace officer, gunsmith, and for 19 firearms repair all other duties requiring gun rights.

C. It shall be unlawful for any person serving a term of probation for any <u>violent</u> felony in any court of this state or of another state or of the United States or under the jurisdiction of any alternative court program to have in his or her possession or under his or her immediate control, or at his or her residence, or

¹ in any passenger vehicle which the person is operating or is riding ² as a passenger, any pistol, shotgun or rifle, including any ³ imitation or homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, <u>toy</u> shotgun ⁴ or <u>toy</u> rifle, while such person is subject to supervision, ⁵ probation, parole or inmate status.

6 D. It shall be unlawful for any person previously adjudicated 7 as a delinquent child or a youthful offender for the commission of 8 an offense, which would have constituted a felony offense if 9 committed by an adult, to have in the possession of the person or 10 under the immediate control of the person, or have in any vehicle 11 which he or she is driving or in which the person is riding as a 12 passenger, or at the residence of the person, any pistol, imitation 13 or homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, machine gun, sawed-14 off shotgun or rifle, or any other dangerous or deadly firearm 15 within ten (10) years after such adjudication; provided, that 16 nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit the 17 placement of the person in a home with a full-time duly appointed 18 peace officer who is certified by the Council on Law Enforcement 19 Education and Training (CLEET) pursuant to the provisions of Section 20 3311 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

E. It shall be unlawful for any person who is an alien illegally or unlawfully in the United States to have in the possession of the person or under the immediate control of the person, or in any vehicle the person is operating, or at the

1 residence where the person resides, any pistol, imitation or 2 homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, shotqun, rifle or any 3 other dangerous or deadly firearm; provided, that nothing in this 4 subsection applies to prohibit the transport or detention of the 5 person by law enforcement officers or federal immigration 6 authorities. Any person who violates the provisions of this 7 subsection shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor 8 punishable by a fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

9 F. Any person having been issued a handgun license pursuant to 10 the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and who thereafter 11 knowingly or intentionally allows a convicted felon or adjudicated 12 delinquent or a youthful offender as prohibited by the provisions of 13 subsection A, C, or D of this section to possess or have control of 14 any pistol firearm authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act 15 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine 16 not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00). In addition, the 17 person shall have the handgun license revoked by the Oklahoma State 18 Bureau of Investigation after a hearing and determination that the 19 person has violated the provisions of this section.

G. Any convicted or adjudicated person violating the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable as provided in Section 1284 of this title.

1 H. For purposes of this section, "sawed-off shotgun" or "sawed-2 off rifle" shall mean any shotgun or rifle which the barrel or 3 barrels has have been illegally shortened to any in length. 4 I. For purposes of this section, "altered toy pistol" shall 5 mean any toy weapon which has been altered from its original 6 manufactured state to resemble a real weapon. 7 J. For purposes of this section, "altered air pistol" shall 8 mean any air pistol manufactured to propel projectiles by air 9 pressure which has been altered from its original manufactured 10 state. 11 K. For purposes of this section, "alternative court program" 12 shall mean any drug court, Anna McBride or mental health court, DUI 13 court or veterans court. 14 SECTION 2.
