5 person resides, any pistol, imitation or homemade pistol, altered  
6 air or toy pistol, machine gun, sawed-off shotgun or sawed-off  
7 rifle, or any other ~~dangerous or deadly~~ firearm.

8 B. Any person who has previously been convicted of a nonviolent  
9 felony in any court of this state or of another state or of the  
10 United States, and who has received a full and complete pardon from  
11 the proper authority and has not been convicted of any other felony  
12 offense which has not been pardoned, shall have restored the right  
13 to possess any firearm or other weapon prohibited by subsection A of  
14 this section, the right to apply for and carry a handgun, concealed  
15 or unconcealed, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-  
16 Defense Act or as otherwise permitted by law, and have the right to  
17 perform the duties of a peace officer, gunsmith, and for firearms  
18 repair.

19 C. It shall be unlawful for any person serving a term of  
20 probation for any felony in any court of this state or of another  
21 state or of the United States or under the jurisdiction of any  
22 alternative court program to have in his or her possession or under  
23 his or her immediate control, or at his or her residence, or in any  
24 passenger vehicle which the person is operating ~~or is riding as a~~

1 ~~passenger~~, any pistol, shotgun or rifle, including any imitation or  
2 homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, toy shotgun or toy  
3 rifle, while such person is subject to supervision, probation,  
4 parole or inmate status.

5 D. It shall be unlawful for any person previously adjudicated  
6 as a delinquent child or a youthful offender for the commission of  
7 an offense, which would have constituted a felony offense if  
8 committed by an adult, to have in the possession of the person or  
9 under the immediate control of the person, or have in any vehicle  
10 which he or she is driving ~~or in which the person is riding as a~~  
11 ~~passenger~~, or at the residence of the person, any pistol, imitation  
12 or homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, machine gun, sawed-  
13 off shotgun or sawed-off rifle, or any other dangerous or deadly  
14 firearm within ten (10) years after such adjudication; provided,  
15 that nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit the  
16 placement of the person in a home with a full-time duly appointed  
17 peace officer who is certified by the Council on Law Enforcement  
18 Education and Training (CLEET) pursuant to the provisions of Section  
19 3311 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

20 E. It shall be unlawful for any person who is an alien  
21 illegally or unlawfully in the United States to have in the  
22 possession of the person or under the immediate control of the  
23 person, or in any vehicle the person is operating, or at the  
24 residence where the person resides, any pistol, imitation or

1 homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, shotgun, rifle or any  
2 other dangerous or deadly firearm; provided, that nothing in this  
3 subsection applies to prohibit the transport or detention of the  
4 person by law enforcement officers or federal immigration  
5 authorities. Any person who violates the provisions of this  
6 subsection shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor  
7 punishable by a fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

8 F. Any person having been issued a handgun license pursuant to  
9 the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and who ~~thereafter~~  
10 knowingly or intentionally allows a convicted felon or adjudicated  
11 delinquent or a youthful offender as prohibited by the provisions of  
12 subsection A, C, or D of this section to possess or have control of  
13 any ~~pistol~~ firearm authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act  
14 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine  
15 not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00). In addition, the  
16 person shall have the handgun license revoked by the Oklahoma State  
17 Bureau of Investigation after a hearing and determination that the  
18 person has violated the provisions of this section.

19 G. Any convicted or adjudicated person violating the provisions  
20 of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony  
21 punishable as provided in Section 1284 of this title.

22 H. For purposes of this section, "sawed-off shotgun" or "sawed-  
23 off rifle" shall mean any shotgun or rifle which the barrel or  
24 barrels ~~has~~ have been illegally shortened ~~to any~~ in length.

1 I. For purposes of this section, "altered toy pistol" shall  
2 mean any toy weapon which has been altered from its original  
3 manufactured state to resemble a real weapon.

4 J. For purposes of this section, "altered air pistol" shall  
5 mean any air pistol manufactured to propel projectiles by air  
6 pressure which has been altered from its original manufactured  
7 state.

8 K. For purposes of this section, "alternative court program"  
9 shall mean any drug court, Anna McBride or mental health court, DUI  
10 court or veterans court.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
