7 An Act relating to the State Department of  
8 Rehabilitation Services; requiring that portions of  
9 certain appropriated funds be used for certain  
10 purposes; prohibiting supplantation of funding;  
11 requiring a certain amount of funding to be budgeted  
12 for a stated purpose; authorizing requests for early  
13 transfers of certain funds for specific purposes;  
14 providing for lapse of funds under certain conditions  
15 requiring certain budget procedures; and prohibiting  
16 certain budget procedures.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the State Department  
19 of Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the  
20 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Five  
21 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used for increased  
22 funding for contracts with organizations that seek to empower blind  
23 or vision impaired individuals to achieve their maximum potential  
24 through rehabilitation, employment and community outreach.

SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the State Department  
of Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the  
2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million

1 Four Hundred Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-one Dollars  
2 (\$2,408,921.00) shall be used for capital improvements at the  
3 Oklahoma School for the Deaf located in Sulphur, Oklahoma.

4 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the State Department  
5 of Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the  
6 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred  
7 Forty-nine Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$149,760.00) shall  
8 be used for the maintenance of the Oklahoma School for the Blind  
9 located in Muskogee, Oklahoma. These funds shall not supplant  
10 current maintenance funding and the agency shall budget no less than  
11 the total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30,  
12 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose.

13 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the State Department  
14 of Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the  
15 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred  
16 Eighty-four Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$184,320.00)  
17 shall be used for the maintenance of the Oklahoma School for the  
18 Deaf located in Sulphur, Oklahoma. These funds shall not supplant  
19 current maintenance funding and the agency shall budget no less than  
20 the total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30,  
21 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose.

22 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the State Department  
23 of Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922 of the  
24 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Eighteen

1 Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$18,267.00) shall be used  
2 for the remaining two (2) months of the teacher pay raise.

3 SECTION 6. The Director of the State Department of  
4 Rehabilitation Services may request through the Director of the  
5 Office of Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by  
6 the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General  
7 Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's  
8 disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

9 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1922  
10 of the 2nd Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature not including  
11 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
12 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21), or may be  
13 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22).  
14 Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
15 2021, and must be expended by November 15, 2021. Any funds  
16 remaining after November 15, 2021, and not budgeted for FY-22, shall  
17 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal  
18 year. Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June  
19 30, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, shall lapse  
20 to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year.  
21 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
22 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-21, and not required to pay  
23 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-22, after  
24 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
