14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-137 of Title 70, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. All entities that apply for additional training programs
18	within the Training for Industry Program provided by the Oklahoma
19	Department of Career and Technology Education shall be required to
20	report to the Department whether the training is for new employee
21	positions within the entity due to an expansion or a new employee
22	for an existing position resulting from employee turnover.

Training agreements between the Department and the entity

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1	include a requirement that the entity annually submit to the
2	Department a report containing the overall retention of employees
3	that receive training for a period of no less than three (3) years
4	following the training.
5	C. The Department may promulgate rules to effectuate the
6	provisions of this section.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
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
