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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to vocational training; requiring
8 certain entities to report certain information on
9 employee positions to the Oklahoma Department of
10 Career and Technology Education; prescribing annual
11 reporting requirements of certain training
12 agreements; authorizing the promulgation of rules;
13 providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-137 of Title 70, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. All entities that apply for additional training programs
20 within the Training for Industry Program provided by the Oklahoma
21 Department of Career and Technology Education shall be required to
22 report to the Department whether the training is for new employee
23 positions within the entity due to an expansion or a new employee
24 for an existing position resulting from employee turnover.

25 B. Training agreements between the Department and the entity
26 for training provided within the Training for Industry Program shall

1 include a requirement that the entity annually submit to the
2 Department a report containing the overall retention of employees
3 that receive training for a period of no less than three (3) years
4 following the training.

5 C. The Department may promulgate rules to effectuate the
6 provisions of this section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.

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
