NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3001 of Title 25, unless there 17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 The use of internal combustion engines including, but not 19 limited to, technology, equipment, mechanical systems, or 20 transportation and gas-fueled stoves, shall not be prohibited by 21 this state or any political subdivision of this state. The rights 22 of individuals in Oklahoma to use internal combustion engines and 23 24 gas-fueled stoves shall be protected in this state.
