10 An Act relating to definitions and general
11 provisions; prohibiting certain future action;
12 declaring protection of certain rights for
13 individuals in Oklahoma; providing for codification;
14 and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3001 of Title 25, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The use of internal combustion engines including, but not
20 limited to, technology, equipment, mechanical systems, or
21 transportation and gas-fueled stoves, shall not be prohibited by
22 this state or any political subdivision of this state. The rights
23 of individuals in Oklahoma to use internal combustion engines and
24 gas-fueled stoves shall be protected in this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
