SENATE BILL 211

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to child care; requiring licensed child care facilities to ensure absence of certain content in specified materials; providing for corrective and administrative action; authorizing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 405.6 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A licensed child care facility shall ensure that no print or nonprint materials or multimedia resources located on the premises of the facility contain any content related to sexual orientation or gender identity.

B. A child care facility found by the Department of Human Services to be in violation of subsection A of this section after complaint and investigation shall be subject to corrective and administrative action as provided by Sections 406 and 407 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

C. The Director of Human Services may promulgate rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
