13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 426.2 of Title 63, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Municipalities, political subdivisions, and counties may enter
18 into agreements or memoranda of understanding with state agencies
19 which respond to search and seizure activities of marijuana to
20 compensate municipalities, political subdivisions, or counties for
21 the use of county or municipal equipment during search and seizure
22 events. Agreements or memoranda made pursuant to the provisions of
23 this section shall not be reimbursed at a higher rate than the
24 federal schedule rate for equipment usage.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
