7	An Act relating to reintegration; creating a task force to study the consideration of creating a tax

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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
18	A. There is hereby created until December 31, 2018, a task
19	force to research the consideration of creating a tax incentive for
20	individuals and businesses that hire ex-offenders once they are
21	released from the Oklahoma prison system.
22	B. The task force shall be comprised of nine (9) members to be
23	appointed as follows:
24	1. Two members appointed by the Governor;

2. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
 2 Senate;

3 3. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
4 Representatives;

5 4. A member representing the Oklahoma Tax Commission;
6 5. A member representing the faith based community of this
7 state; and

6. A member representing the Oklahoma Pardon and Parole Board.
9 The chair of the task force shall be selected by the Governor.
10 C. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any
11 final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, five
12 (5) members shall constitute a quorum.

D. The task force may meet as often as may be required in order to perform the duties imposed upon it. The chair shall call the first meeting and all subsequent meetings shall be made at the call of the chair.

E. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to theOklahoma Open Meeting Act.

19 F. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or20 travel reimbursement.

G. Staff support shall be provided by the Senate.

H. The task force shall submit a report of its findings andrecommendations by December 15, 2018, to the Governor, the President
