12 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
13 entire bill and insert
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15 "An Act relating to the Board of Mental Health and
16 Substance Abuse Services; amending 43A O.S. 2011,
17 Section 2-103, which relates to composition of the
18 Board; modifying Board membership; permitting
osteopathic physicians to serve concurrently on
State Board of Osteopathic Examiners; and providing
an effective date.

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 2-103, is
23 amended to read as follows:
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1 Section 2-103. A. The Board of Mental Health and Substance
2 Abuse Services shall be composed of eleven (11) members, appointed
3 by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate. Each
4 term is for a seven-year period and members may be reappointed to
5 subsequent terms. Board members shall meet the following criteria:

6 1. One member, who shall be a physician licensed to practice in
7 this state, and one member, who shall be a psychiatrist certified as
8 a diplomate of the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, shall
9 both be appointed from a list containing the names of not less than
10 three physicians and not less than three psychiatrists submitted to
11 the Governor by the Oklahoma State Medical Association;

12 2. Two members shall be osteopathic physicians licensed to
13 practice in this state, appointed from a list containing the names
14 of not less than six osteopathic physicians submitted to the
15 Governor by the Oklahoma Osteopathic Association;

16 3. One member, who shall be an attorney licensed to practice in
17 this state and shall be appointed from a list of not less than three
18 names submitted to the Governor by the Board of Governors of the
19 Oklahoma Bar Association;

20 ~~3.~~ 4. One member, who shall be a psychologist, licensed to
21 practice in this state, who shall be appointed from a list of not
22 less than three names submitted to the Governor by the Oklahoma
23 State Psychological Association;

1 ~~4.~~ 5. Three members, qualified by education and experience in
2 the area of substance abuse recovery, who shall be appointed from a
3 list of not less than ten names submitted to the Governor by a state
4 association of substance abuse recovery programs or organizations;
5 and

6 ~~5.—Four~~ 6. Two members who shall be citizens of this state, at
7 least one of whom shall be either a current or former consumer of
8 mental health services.

9 B. No person shall be appointed a member of the Board who has
10 been a member of the Legislature of this state within the preceding
11 five (5) years.

12 C. The Board shall elect from among its members a chair and a
13 vice-chair. The chair may call meetings at any time.

14 D. All regularly scheduled meetings of the Board shall be held
15 at the Central Office of the Department of Mental Health and
16 Substance Abuse Services, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, unless otherwise
17 scheduled. Six members shall constitute a quorum at any meeting,
18 and all action may be taken by an affirmative vote of the majority
19 of the members present at any such meeting.

20 E. The action taken by the Board on any matter, or any document
21 passed by the Board, shall be considered official when such action
22 is placed in writing and signed by the chair or vice-chair.

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1 F. The duties of the Board shall pertain to the care,
2 treatment, and hospitalization of persons with mental illness, or
3 alcohol- or drug-dependent persons.

4 G. Members of the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
5 Services shall be allowed their necessary travel expenses pursuant
6 to the provisions of the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

7 H. Members of the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
8 Services shall be allowed to serve on the State Board of Medical
9 Licensure and Supervision and the State Board of Osteopathic
10 Examiners during members' terms on the Board of Mental Health and
11 Substance Abuse Services.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015."
