8 b. the date the candidate registered as a voter of that

10 registration, pursuant to subsection D of Section 4-

12 c. if the date shown in subparagraph b of this paragraph

13 is six (6) months or less immediately preceding the

14 first day of the filing period but the candidate was

15 previously registered in a different county prior to

16 registering in the current county, the candidate shall

17 provide the name of the previous county and the date

18 the candidate registered as a voter of that political

19 party in the previous county pursuant to subsection D

20 of Section 4-110.1 of this title;

21 7. The voter registration identification number of the

22 candidate and the precinct and county wherein the candidate is a

23 registered voter;

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1           8. An oath wherein the candidate swears or affirms that he or  
2 she is qualified to become a candidate for the office sought, and  
3 that, if elected, the candidate will be qualified to hold the  
4 office; and

5           9. Any additional information which the Secretary deems  
6 necessary.

7           B. If the candidate has ever been ultimately determined by a  
8 court of proper authority to be guilty of an offense specified in  
9 subsection A of Section 5-105a of this title or at the time of  
10 filing the Declaration of Candidacy is named in an outstanding  
11 warrant for arrest for such an offense, in this or any other state,  
12 the candidate shall provide the following information on a form  
13 prescribed by the Secretary of the State Election Board:

14           1. The name of the offense;

15           2. The date of conviction or issuance of the outstanding  
16 warrant; and

17           3. The county and state of conviction or issuance of the  
18 outstanding warrant.

19           The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to an offense  
20 for which the candidate has received a pardon.

21           C. A Declaration of Candidacy form must be signed by the  
22 candidate, and the signature must be properly notarized by a notary  
23 public or other person authorized by law to administer oaths.

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1 D. In addition to the information required by this section, a  
2 candidate may include a telephone number, email address and website  
3 address. Such additional information shall not be required of any  
4 candidate but if provided shall be made available to the public.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
