The driver of any a vehicle involved in an accident resulting only in damage to a vehicle which is driven or 16 attended by any another person shall immediately stop such the 17 vehicle at the scene of such the accident or as close thereto as 18 possible but, and shall forthwith immediately return to and in every 19 event shall remain at the scene of such the accident until he the 20 driver has fulfilled the requirements of Section 10-104 of this 21 title. Every such stop shall be made without obstructing traffic 22 more than is necessary. Any person failing to stop or to comply 23

with said the requirements under such circumstances of this section

1	shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall
2	be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)
3	or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one (1)
4	year, or by both such fine and imprisonment. In addition to the
5	criminal penalties imposed by this section, any person violating the
6	provisions of this section shall be subject to liability for damages
7	in an amount equal to three times the value of the damage caused by
8	the accident. Said damages shall be recoverable in a civil action.
