8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Medicaid Program;
9 directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to contract
10 for certain purposes; providing guidelines for audit;
11 requiring certain provisions in contract; directing
12 promulgation of rules; providing for noncodification;
13 and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall contract for an
18 independent audit to identify ineligible participants in the
19 Oklahoma Medicaid Program. The purpose of the audit shall be to
20 identify, investigate, and resolve potential cases of fraud,
21 misrepresentation or inadequate documentation prior to determining
22 an applicant's eligibility for assistance under the Oklahoma
23 Medicaid Program.

24 B. The contract for the audit required by this act shall ensure
that the audit analyze the eligibility of all participants in the

1 Oklahoma Medicaid Program. The contract shall specify that payment
2 by the Authority to the business entity performing the services
3 required by this act be distributed only as performance-based goals
4 are attained.

5 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate
6 rules to implement the provisions of this act.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.

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
