11 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
12 entire bill and insert

13 "An Act relating to teacher certification; directing
14 the State Department of Education to provide certain
15 written notice to individuals whose license or
16 certificate expired on certain date; providing for
17 renewal of expired licenses and certificates if
18 application is submitted by certain date; providing
19 for effective dates of renewal applications;
20 providing for processing fees for renewal
21 applications on expired licenses and certificates;
22 providing for codification; providing an effective
23 date; and declaring an emergency.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-108.1 of Title 70, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. No later than October 1 of each year, the State Department
2 of Education shall provide written notice to the last-known address
3 of any individual who held any license or certificate issued by the
4 State Board of Education which expired on June 30 of the same year.
5 Notice shall also be provided to the last-known district which
6 employed any such individual.

7 B. If any individual whose license or certificate issued by the
8 State Board of Education has expired submits a renewal application
9 and processing fee by December 31 of the year in which the license
10 or certificate has expired, such license or certificate shall be
11 renewed with an effective date of July 1 of the year in which the
12 license or certificate has expired, unless other statutory basis
13 exists for denying such renewal.

14 C. If any individual whose license or certificate issued by the
15 State Board of Education has expired submits a renewal application
16 and processing fee after December 31 of the year in which the
17 license or certificate has expired, such license or certificate
18 shall be renewed with an effective date in accordance with State
19 Department of Education rules, unless another statutory basis exists
20 for denying such renewal.

21 D. The processing fee for late renewal of a license or
22 certificate shall not exceed one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the
23 standard renewal processing fee for renewal applications submitted
24 by December 31 of the year in which the license or certificate has

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

10 D. The processing fee for late renewal of a license or
11 certificate shall not exceed one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the
12 standard renewal processing fee for renewal applications submitted
13 by December 31 of the year in which the license or certificate has
14 expired, or two hundred percent (200%) of the standard renewal
15 processing fee for renewal applications submitted after December 31
16 of the year in which the license or certificate has expired.

17 ~~SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.~~

18 ~~SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation~~
19 ~~of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby~~
20 ~~declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and~~
21 ~~be in full force from and after its passage and approval.~~
