10 ~~C. B.~~ Precinct officials assigned to work a polling place ten  
11 (10) miles or more from their home, shall be allowed mileage  
12 reimbursement at the rate provided by the State Travel Reimbursement  
13 Act for mileage incurred from their home to and from their assigned  
14 polling place. In addition, inspectors shall be allowed mileage  
15 reimbursement at the rate provided by the State Travel Reimbursement  
16 Act for mileage incurred to receive or return ballots and materials  
17 for the election.

18 ~~D. C.~~ Compensation and mileage reimbursement provided ~~herein~~  
19 shall be paid for any election conducted by a county election board.

20 ~~E. D.~~ 1. Five Dollars (\$5.00) of the compensation described in  
21 subsections ~~A, and B and C~~ A, and B of this section shall be paid by the  
22 county election board from county funds and the remainder shall be  
23 paid by the State Election Board for all regular Primary, Runoff  
24 Primary and General Elections for state and federal offices, for the

1 Presidential Preferential Primary Election, and for all statewide  
2 special elections and all special elections for United States  
3 Representatives or United States Senators and State Senators or  
4 State Representatives.

5 2. Except for elections described in paragraph 1 of this  
6 subsection, for all other elections conducted by a county election  
7 board, the entity for which the election is being conducted shall  
8 pay the compensation and mileage reimbursement described in  
9 subsections ~~A~~ A and ~~B~~ B and ~~C~~ of this section; provided, if an  
10 election for more than one entity is conducted in the same precinct,  
11 the entities shall equally share the cost of precinct official  
12 compensation and mileage reimbursement for that precinct.

13 ~~F.~~ E. The secretary of the county election board may appoint  
14 volunteer precinct officials who shall not receive the compensation  
15 provided ~~herein~~ by this section.

16 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
