14	Section 426. A. The An excise tax on retail medical marijuana
15	sales will be established at is hereby levied at the rate of seven
16	percent (7%) of the gross amount received <u>sales</u> by the seller. <u>In</u>
17	addition, such sales shall be subject to state sales tax and any
18	applicable county and local sales taxes.
19	B. This tax will The taxes shall be collected at the point of
20	sale. Tax proceeds will be applied primarily to finance the
21	regulatory office shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Medical
22	Marijuana Tax Revenue Fund and shall be expended in accordance with
23	subsection C of this section.

1	C. If proceeds from the levy authorized by subsection A of this
2	section exceed the budgeted amount for running the regulatory
3	office, any surplus shall be apportioned with seventy-five percent
4	(75%) going to the General Revenue Fund and may only be expended for
5	common education. Twenty-five percent (25%) shall be apportioned to
6	the Oklahoma State Department of Health and earmarked for drug and
7	alcohol rehabilitation
8	There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund to be
9	designated the "Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Tax Revenue Fund". The

 Department of Health;
 - 2. Substance abuse prevention and treatment programs; and
 - Common education.
