- - B. 1. The sale of retail medical marijuana shall be subject to applicable state and local sales tax.
 - 2. Proceeds from state sales tax shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1353 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
 - 3. Proceeds from local sales tax shall be remitted to the county and municipal governments when the point of sale is located within the boundaries of the applicable political subdivision.
 - C. If proceeds from the levy authorized by subsection A of this section exceed the budgeted amount for running the regulatory office, any surplus shall be apportioned with There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund to be designated the "Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Tax Revenue Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of monies received pursuant to subsection A of this section and any monies designated to the fund by law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund shall be appropriated at the discretion of the Legislature for the operation of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority of the State Department of Health; provided, the amount not appropriated to the Authority shall be appropriated with seventy-five percent (75%) going to the Ceneral Revenue Fund and may only to be expended for common education. Twenty-five and twenty-five percent (25%) shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma State
