AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22 O.S. 2011, Section 231, which relates to misdemeanor warrants; imposing time limitation on validity of misdemeanor warrant; requiring inclusion of expiration date on misdemeanor warrant; providing for retroactive application of certain provisions; making language gender neutral; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. 22 O.S. 2011, Section 231, is AMENDATORY amended to read as follows:

Section 231. A. In all misdemeanor cases, before a warrant shall issue for the arrest of the defendant the complaint must be submitted to or drawn by the district attorney, or drawn by him and indorsed as follows: "I have examined the facts in this case and recommend that a warrant do issue", and then filed with the court. If the action be brought without such endorsement the complaining witness must file with the court a bond to be approved by the court in a sum not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), conditioned to pay all costs, and the county shall in no event be liable for any costs

1	incurred in that action, unless the complaint be first so endorsed
2	by the district attorney.
3	B. A misdemeanor warrant shall not be effective for an amount
4	of time greater than the statute of limitations for the underlying
5	crime pursuant to Section 152 of this title. Every misdemeanor
6	warrant issued shall include a date of expiration not longer than
7	three (3) years after issuance, after which the warrant shall no
8	longer be valid. The requirements of this subsection shall be
9	applied retroactively to any outstanding misdemeanor warrant.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
