19	voter to mark the ballots in accordance with the provisions of
20	Section 7-123.3 of this title and as prescribed by the Secretary of
21	the State Election Board; seal
22	2. Sealing the ballots in the plain opaque envelope; fill
23	3. Filling out completely and sign signing the affidavit or
24	$\frac{direct}{directing}$ a person chosen by the voter to sign the <u>voter's</u>

5 bearing the affidavit and return returning both envelopes, sealed

9 B. No person, except members of absentee voting boards, shall 10 witness the signature of more than five affidavits of persons who 11 swear they are physically incapacitated and unable to vote in person 12 at their precinct on election day. No person who is a candidate for 13 an office on the ballot or who is related within the third degree of 14 consanguinity or affinity to a candidate on the ballot may witness 15 any absentee ballot affidavit.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
