15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill  
16 and insert

17 "An Act relating to counties; amending 19 O.S. 2011,  
18 Section 941, which relates to county parking lots;  
19 eliminating population restriction to allow for  
20 installation and operation of county-owned parking  
21 lots; providing an effective date; and declaring an  
22 emergency.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 941, is  
amended to read as follows:

1 Section 941. In any county in the State of Oklahoma ~~having a~~  
2 ~~population of more than three hundred thousand (300,000),~~ the board  
3 of commissioners of each county of the state is hereby authorized in  
4 its discretion, by the adoption of a resolution to set forth in its  
5 minutes, to install and operate on any tract of land of the county  
6 not needed or used for other county purposes county parking lots on  
7 which motor and other vehicles may be parked, and may charge parking  
8 fees therefor, and may install parking meters or other parking  
9 control devices, all as provided for and fixed in said resolution.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 941. In any county in the State of Oklahoma having a  
16 population of more than ~~three hundred thousand (300,000)~~ two hundred  
17 fifty thousand (250,000), the board of commissioners of each county  
18 of the state is hereby authorized in its discretion, by the adoption  
19 of a resolution to set forth in its minutes, to install and operate  
20 on any tract of land of the county not needed or used for other  
21 county purposes county parking lots on which motor and other  
22 vehicles may be parked, and may charge parking fees therefor, and  
23 may install parking meters or other parking control devices, all as  
24 provided for and fixed in said resolution.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

1 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
