17	A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall serve as

21	B. As the state's principal assistance organization under the

23	qualified businesses in this state and for transitioning

servicemembers who reside in, or who wish to reside in, this state, the Department shall:

- Establish and maintain, as applicable, its certification for the SkillsBridge program or any other similar workforce training and transition programs established by the United States Department of Defense;
- 2. Educate businesses, business associations, and transitioning servicemembers on the SkillBridge program and its benefits, and educate military command and personnel within the state on opportunities available to transitioning servicemembers through the SkillBridge program;
- 3. Assist businesses in obtaining approval for skilled workforce training curricula under the SkillsBridge program, including, but not limited to, apprenticeships, internships, or fellowships; and
- Match transitioning servicemembers who are deemed eligible for SkillsBridge participation by their military command with training opportunities offered by the corporation or participating businesses, with the intent of having transitioning servicemembers achieve gainful employment in this state upon completion of their SkillsBridge training.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
