- - 2. "Veterans' preference employment policy" means an employer's voluntary preference for hiring, promoting or retaining a veteran; and
 - 3. "Veteran" means a person who has been honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United States.
 - B. An employer may have a voluntary veterans' preference employment policy.
 - C. The veterans' preference employment policy:
 - 1. Shall be in writing; and
- 2. Shall be applied uniformly to employment decisions regarding the hiring, promotion, or retention during a reduction in force.
 - D. A veteran shall submit a DD 214 of the veteran to an employer with a veterans' preference employment policy to be eligible for the preference.
- SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
