12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 858-202, is

14	Section 858-202. A. Members of the Oklahoma Real Estate
15	Commission shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and
16	consent of the Senate.
17	B. Members of the Commission shall serve until their terms
18	expire. The terms of the Commission members shall be for four (4)
19	years and until their successors are appointed and qualified.
20	C. Each successor member and any vacancy which may occur in the
21	membership of the Commission shall be filled by appointment of the
22	Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
23	D. The Governor may select appointees from a list of $rac{dt}{dt}$ least
24	up to three qualified persons submitted by the Oklahoma Association

1 of Realtors, Incorporated <u>a statewide organization representing</u>
2 realtors.

E. Each person who shall have been appointed to fill a vacancy
shall serve for the remainder of the term for which the member whom
he <u>or she</u> will succeed was appointed and until his <u>or her</u> successor,
in turn, shall have been appointed and shall have qualified.
F. Members of the Commission may be removed from office by the

Governor for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance in office in the manner provided by law for the removal of officers not subject to impeachment. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015. 55-1-1127 NP 6/3/2015 11:29:04 AM
