14	effective date of this act, shall expire on the last day of the
15	calendar year be valid for a four-year term and may be renewed upon
16	application to the Commissioner as prescribed by his or her
17	regulation. Each application for an original or renewal school
18	license shall be accompanied by a fee of Twenty-five Dollars
19	(\$25.00) One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Each application for an
20	original or renewal instructor's license shall be accompanied by a
21	fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). The license
22	fees collected pursuant to Sections 801 through 808 of this title
23	shall be remitted to the State Treasurer to be credited to the
24	General Revenue Fund in the State Treasury. No license fee shall be

refunded in the event that the license is rejected, suspended, or
