NEW LAW 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1992 of Title 63, unless there 15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 Α. The State Department of Health shall create a pilot program 17 to train primary care physicians in rural areas on the diagnosing 18 and treatment of Alzheimer's and dementia. Under the program, the 19 Department shall identify a neurologist, who may live in an urban 20 area, to utilize Project ECHO (Extension for Community Healthcare 21 Outcomes) or another guided practice model to train and mentor rural 22 primary care physicians. The neurologist shall not receive

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compensation.

1	B. As used in this section, "Project ECHO" is a global,
2	collaborative model of medical education and care management which
3	utilizes teleconferencing to link expert specialist teams at an
4	academic hub with primary care physicians in local communities to
5	increase medical knowledge and develop the skills of primary care
6	physicians in rural and underserved areas.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
