The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority shall promulgate rules to limit the tetrahydrocannabinol 14 (THC) potency of medical marijuana and medical marijuana products 15 sold in medical marijuana dispensaries. The limits imposed by such 16 rules shall be at the discretion of the Executive Director, provided 17 that the limits do not exceed: 18 1. Thirty percent (30%) delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol potency 19 for medical marijuana and sixty percent (60%) delta-9 20 tetrahydrocannabinol potency for medical marijuana products; 21 Two percent (2%) delta-8 tetrahydrocannabinol potency for 22 medical marijuana and medical marijuana products; and 23

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1	3. Zero percent (0%) potency of delta-10 tetrahydrocannabinol
2	and all other isomers, precursors, and other variations of

5	B. A licensed medical marijuana dispensary shall not sell any
6	medical marijuana or medical marijuana product that exceeds the THC
