6 An Act relating to motor vehicles; prohibiting
7 contracting for use of photo monitoring devices;
8 defining terms; providing for codification; and
9 providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-226 of Title 47, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. No state agency, county, municipality or political
15 subdivision may contract with any private corporation to provide for
16 the use of any photo monitoring device to detect any traffic control
17 signal violation.

18 B. As used in this section, the term "photo monitoring device"
19 means a stationary, unmanned device used with a lighted traffic
20 control device to detect a traffic control signal violation and
21 captures photographic identification of the vehicle that results in
22 the issuance of a citation against the registrant, rather than the
23 driver, of the vehicle.

1 C. As used in this section, the term "traffic control signal"
2 means any device, whether manually, electronically or mechanically
3 operated, by which traffic is alternately directed to stop and
4 proceed.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
