10	An Act relating to veterans; amending Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1189 of the 1st Session of
11	the 56th Legislature; modifying the registry to allow development of a separate list of all 100% service-
12	disabled veterans within the registry; and requiring the Department to verify the service disability
13	status of all 100% service disabled veterans in the registry every four years; and providing an effective
14 15	date.
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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill
19	No. 1198 of the 1st Session of the 56th Oklahoma Legislature, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	Section 421. A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs
22	shall create and maintain a registry of all veterans in this state
23	by January 1, 2020. The registry shall include the following
24	information regarding the veteran:

1	1. Name;
2	2. Military ranking and branch of service;
3	3. Dates of service; <del>and</del>
4	4. Documentation of one hundred percent (100%) service-
5	disability, if applicable; and
6	5. Date of death and place of burial, if applicable.
7	B. As a component of the veterans registry created pursuant to
8	subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans
9	Affairs shall designate those veterans within the registry as one
10	hundred percent (100%) service-disabled Oklahoma veterans, if
11	applicable. The registry designation shall also be maintained as a
12	separate list within the registry for all one hundred percent (100%)
13	service-disabled Oklahoma veterans. The Department shall be
14	responsible for verification of all information provided through the
15	registry and shall verify veteran service disability status at least
16	once every four (4) years.
17	<u>C.</u> The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall promulgate
18	rules for implementing the provisions of this section.
19	<del>C.</del> <u>D.</u> For purposes of this section, "veteran" means a person
20	who served on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States
21	who was discharged or released with an honorable discharge. For
22	those veterans with a designation of one hundred percent (100%)
23	service-disabled, the veteran shall have been assigned a disability
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1	percentage of one hundred percent (100%) by the United States
2	Department of Veterans Affairs.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
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
