14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 135, O.S.L.
15	2022 (70 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 509.12), is amended to read as
16	follows:
17	Section 509.12. A. A school district board of education may
18	approve a request from a school district employee for a leave of
19	absence to hold office as an officer, director, trustee, or agent of
20	a national, statewide, or school district employee association. The
21	employee requesting the leave shall provide the school district
22	superintendent with proof of election and proof of the term of
23	office for the national, statewide, or school district employee
24 2 -	association. Proof of election shall include but not be limited to

<sup>3</sup> the election. Board of education approval for leave requested
<sup>4</sup> pursuant to this section shall have definitive beginning and end

B. Leave granted pursuant to this section shall be leave
without pay. The school employee on leave shall not be entitled to
maintain any benefits granted by the school district regardless of
whether the benefit is paid by the employee on leave or the
association for which the person is serving as an officer, director,
trustee, or agent may be allowed to retain insurance coverage
pursuant to Section 1308.1 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

13 C. During the leave period, the school employee's position with 14 the school district shall be maintained without advancement on the 15 minimum salary schedule adopted pursuant to Section 5-141 of Title 16 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title and with no accrual of sick 17 leave, personal business leave, or personal leave. The employee on 18 leave shall not accumulate service credit within the Teachers' 19 Retirement System of Oklahoma. Following the term of leave granted 20 pursuant to the provisions of this section, the employee granted 21 leave may return to his or her former position or a comparable 22 position.

D. A school district employee granted leave pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be prohibited from accessing school district office space.

4 E. If a national, statewide, or school district employee 5 association that serves as a school district employee organization 6 established pursuant to Section 509.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma 7 Statutes this title fails to comply with the provisions of this 8 section, the school district board of education shall no longer 9 recognize the organization as a representative of employees. 10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023. 11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation

<sup>12</sup> of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby <sup>13</sup> declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and <sup>14</sup> be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
