SENATE BILL NO. 50 By: Young

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AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring school districts, in certain coordination, to provide students in certain grades and their parents or legal guardians certain communication training annually; providing for focus of training; encouraging school districts to work with certain community-based organizations; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100.9 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. Each public school district, in coordination with the school district's Safe School Committee established pursuant to Section 24-100.5 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall provide to students in grades six through twelve and their parents or legal guardians at least one parent-child communication training annually. The training shall focus on parents or legal guardians having a well-informed, factually based, medically accurate and body-positive communication with their children regarding pregnancy prevention,

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abstinence practices, prevention of sexually transmitted infections and diseases and safe and healthy relationships. School districts shall be encouraged to work with community-В. based organizations with proven expertise in the subject areas to provide materials and resources, including personnel. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 57-1-1617 EΒ 12/13/2018 2:24:26 PM 

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
