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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 389, O.S.L.
15	2015 (22 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 60.31), is amended to read as
16	follows:
17	Section 60.31. A. Beginning on January 1, 2016, any
18	governmental entity in a county that receives sufficient funds to
19	implement such program may establish a family justice center to
20	assist victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, elder or
21	dependent adult abuse and stalking to ensure that victims of abuse
22	are able to access all needed services in one location in order to
23	enhance victim safety and increase offender accountability. Family
24	justice centers shall comply with all applicable laws and

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regulations of this state, and may include, but not be limited to,

the participation of law enforcement, the prosecuting authority, and

an Attorney General certified victim services agency.
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- B. 1. Except as otherwise provided by paragraph 3 of this subsection, the case records, case files, case notes, client records or similar records of a family justice center or of any employee or trained volunteer of such center regarding an individual who is utilizing the services of any family justice center program or counselor shall be confidential and shall not be disclosed.
- 2. For purposes of this subsection, the term "client records" shall include, but not be limited to, all communications, records, and information regarding clients of family justice center programs.
- 3. The case records, case files, or case notes of programs specified in paragraph 1 of this subsection shall be confidential and shall not be disclosed except with the written consent of the individual, or in the case of the individual's death or disability, of the individual's personal representative or other person authorized to sue on the individual's behalf or by court order for good cause shown by the judge in camera.
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
