7	An Act relating to motorcycles; amending 47 O.S.
8	2011, Section 12-602, which relates to headlamps on motorcycles; modifying allowances; and providing an
9	effective date.

11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 12-602, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 12-602. A. Every motorcycle shall be equipped with at
15	least one headlamp emitting a white light which shall comply with
16	the applicable requirements and limitations of Section 12-203 of
17	this title and of Sections 12-224 <u>12-602.1</u> , 12-225 <u>12-203.4</u> , 12-227
18	and 12-228 of this title.
19	B. Every headlamp upon every motorcycle shall be located at a
20	height of not more than fifty-four (54) inches nor less than twenty-
21	two (22) inches to be measured as set forth in subsection B of
22	Section 12-202 of this title.

1	C. Subject to subsections A and B of this section, a motorcycle
2	may be equipped with, and an operator of a motorcycle may use, the
3	following auxiliary lighting:
4	1. Standard bulb running lights; or
5	2. Light-emitting diode pods and strips.
6	D. Lighting under subsection C of this section shall be:
7	<u>1. Nonblinking;</u>
8	2. Nonflashing;
9	3. Nonoscillating; and
10	4. Directed toward the engine and the drive train of the
11	motorcycle to prevent interference with the driver's operation of
12	the vehicle.
13	E. For purposes of this section:
14	1. "Headlamp" shall not include passing lamp; and
15	2. "Passing lamp" shall mean an auxiliary front low-beam lamp
16	which emits a white light.
17	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
