17	A. Every person convicted of violating any section of the
18	Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Code shall be required to complete a
19	six (6) hour wildlife conservation education program. The program
20	shall be attended in person by the violator at a location provided
21	by the Department of Wildlife Conservation.
22	B. The Department shall create a wildlife conservation
23	education program and promulgate rules necessary for the
