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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-282, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 6-282. As used in <del>this act</del> <u>Section 6-281 et seq. of</u>
19	this title unless the context otherwise requires:
20	1. "Equine infectious anemia" or "EIA" means the communicable,
21	infectious disease which affects only equidae and is caused by the
22	virus of equine infectious anemia;
23	2. "Board" means the <del>Oklahoma</del> State Board of Agriculture;
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1	3. "Equidae" means a family of perissodactyl ungulate mammals
2	containing a single genus, Equus, which includes horses, asses,
3	jacks, jennies, hinnies, mules, donkeys, burros, ponies and zebras;
4	4. "Official test" means <del>the Agar-Gel Immunodiffusion (AGID)</del> <u>a</u>
5	test for equine infectious anemia which has been conducted in a
6	laboratory approved by the Board $rac{\Theta r}{\Theta}$ and the United States Department
7	of Agriculture for the purpose of conducting this test or any other
8	test or examination for the detection of equine infectious anemia
9	approved by the Department; and
10	5. "Reactor" means any equidae which discloses a positive
11	reaction to an official test for equine infectious anemia.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
